

MOUNTAIN LEADER AWARD TRAINING/ASSESSMENT



The Training and Assessment Courses are for adults who have a genuine interest in hill walking and group leadership who wish to lead young people and adults in the mountains of the United Kingdom.

The **Training** includes theoretical and practical sessions on the main aspects of the ML Award (summer) scheme syllabus and will involve an overnight expedition. The course is for potential

Leaders and assumes basic competence as a hillwalker. You will be issued with a logbook which you should complete and forward before the course. Twenty quality mountain days is the normally accepted minimum level of experience for attendance on the training course.

Assessment Candidates will need to have undertaken a training course and fulfilled all requirements of the scheme before assessment. During the course you will undergo continuous assessment where you will need to demonstrate your competence in all aspects of the syllabus. The course involves a 3-day expedition.
