HILL AND MOORLAND LEADER AWARD TRAINING AND ASSESSMENT COURSES



The separate **Training** and **Assessment** Courses are for adults who have a genuine interest in hill walking and group leadership who wish to lead young people and adults in non-mountainous high or open country in the United Kingdom.

The <u>Training</u> includes theoretical and practical sessions on the main aspects of the HML Award scheme syllabus. The course is for potential Leaders and assumes basic competence as a hillwalker.

You will need to be registered for the HML Award with Mountain Training and create an account on their Candidate Management System (CMS). Log your experience via the DLOG system. You should complete this before the course. Twenty 'quality hill walking days' is the normally accepted minimum level of experience for attendance on the training course. <u>Assessment</u> Candidates will need to have undertaken a training course and HAVE fulfilled all requirements of the scheme before assessment including 40 walking days. During the course there will be assessment on the hillside and also include some written tests where you will need to demonstrate your competence in all aspects of the syllabus.



Included: The course fee includes necessary specialist equipment, instruction, transport whilst on the course, course administration and catered accommodation.

Not included: Transport to and from Plas Pencelli or personal accident insurance (The Centre holds Professional Indemnity and 3rd party liability insurance policies).
