

## LOWLAND LEADER AWARD TRAINING AND ASSESSMENT COURSES



The Lowland Leader award has been designed for people with some walking experience who wish to lead groups on day walks on footpaths, trails and in lowland countryside and woodland in summer conditions anywhere in the UK and Ireland. The separate **Training** and **Assessment** Courses are based on the Lowland Leader Syllabus set out by Mountain Training. <http://www.mountain-training.org/walking/skills-and-awards/lowland-leader>

**Training** You will need to be registered with Mountain Training and create an account on their Candidate Management System (CMS), and log your experience via the DLOG system. You should complete this before the course. Ten varied walks in Lowland terrain where the use of a map is required is the minimum level of experience for attendance on the training course. **Assessment** Candidates will need to have undertaken a training course and HAVE fulfilled all requirements of the scheme before assessment including 20 walks in lowland countryside in different types of terrain. You must hold a current first aid certificate, minimum of 16hrs and relevant to your work as a Lowland Leader.



*Included:* The course fee includes necessary specialist equipment, instruction, transport whilst on the course, course administration and catered accommodation.

*Not included:* Transport to and from Plas Pencelli or personal accident insurance (The Centre holds Professional Indemnity and 3rd party liability insurance policies).
