Details

- Casual contract - on going.
- Pay rate equates to £14.41 hour (which includes adjustment for holiday entitlement).
- Normal work pattern Monday to Friday 8.45am – 5.15pm – 8 hours a day.
- Normally one evening duty (5.15pm – 9.15pm.) – 4 hours.
- Working mainly with mainstream school children with an outdoor educational ethos.

- A career outdoor educationalist with evidence of a higher level of learning in the field and with a child centred approach.
- Should be reliable, flexible and with a positive outlook
- Able to align with centre norms and objectives.
- Ideally have some experience of working successfully in similar settings
- Have at least 2 NGB leadership qualifications for caving, hill walking in wild country, rock climbing outdoors and canoeing and a current 1st aid certificate.
- Ideally possess a driving licence and D1 endorsement

Job role

- Leading groups of young people on a range of outdoor activities accessed via minibus.
- Each day setting learning objectives, focusing on student personal development and reviewing the day in line with centre
- Running evening activities usually one evening a week
- Assisting with the general running of the centre
- Taking part in supervision, training and staff meeting events

- All equipment required for the role will be supplied (though most staff will want to use their own safety equipment such as first aid kit, head torch etc.)
- Packed lunch and hot drinks each day
- Staff briefings each morning
- Telephone and other staff support during the day

- Opportunity to loan of outdoor equipment for personal use
