- Have at least 2 NGB leadership qualifications in caving, outdoor climbing, canoeing and hill walking.
- Hold a current 16hr outdoor 1st aid certificate.
- Possess a full driving licence, ideally with D1 endorsement.

Job role

- Leading groups of young people on a range of offsite outdoor activities.
- Setting learning objectives, focusing on student personal development, and reviewing each day.
- Facilitating onsite evening activities, usually one evening a week.
- Assisting with the general running of the centre.
- Taking part in supervision, training, and staff meetings.

- All equipment required for the role will be supplied.
- Packed lunch and hot drinks supplied each day in lieu of lunchtime supervision.
- Staff briefings each morning.
- Phone and other staff support during the day.
- 1 to 1 liaison on work schedules.
