

## HILL AND MOORLAND LEADER AWARD



The **Training and Assessment** Courses are for adults who have a genuine interest in hill walking and group leadership who wish to lead young people and adults in the non-mountainous high or open country in the United Kingdom.

The **Training** includes theoretical and practical sessions on the main aspects of the H&ML Award scheme syllabus. The course is for potential Leaders and assumes basic competence as a hillwalker.

You will need to be registered with the ML and create an account on their Candidate Management System (CMS). Logging your experience via the DLOG which you should complete before the course. Twenty quality mountain days is the normally accepted minimum level of experience for attendance on the training course. **Assessment** Candidates will need to have undertaken a training course and fulfilled all requirements of the scheme before assessment including 40 walking days. During the course you will undergo continuous assessment on the hillside and written tests where you will need to demonstrate your competence in all aspects of the syllabus.

*Included:* The course fee includes necessary specialist equipment, instruction, transport whilst on the course, course administration and catered accommodation.

*Not included:* Transport to and from Plas Pencelli or personal accident insurance (The Centre holds Professional Indemnity and 3rd party liability insurance policies).
